Shomie Ranjan Das (born 28th August, 1935) is an Indian educationist. An alumnus of The Doon School, he has served as the Headmaster of The Doon School, Mayo College and Lawrence School, Sanawar. He had earlier taught in Gordonstoun School in the UK,

After his earlier education at The Doon School, he graduated from St. Xavier's College of the University of Calcutta and the University of Cambridge. After working at Gordonstoun School, he was the Principal of Mayo College from 1969 to 1974. He then became Headmaster of the Lawrence School, Sanawar in 1974 and held this position until 1988. He served as the Headmaster of The Doon School from 1988 to 1995. After he retired from The Doon School, he became an educational consultant and was instrumental in setting up many new schools all over the country.

Our Teaching Learning Pedagogy

The school is affiliated to the CBSE. Jain International School delivers a dynamic and evolved educational programme that encourages each student to achieve his or her highest potential.



- *Evaluation is the most tangible source of student performance. The school strictly adheres to a policy in which academics, co-curricular activities, attitudes & values are given equal importance.*
- *JIS aims at evaluating what a child knows, rather than what a child doesn't. The focus is on understanding the strengths & weaknesses of the child.*
- *At the Pre-primary and Primary level a continuous and comprehensive evaluation system is followed in which every subject is broken down into micro skills and learning objectives and these are then assessed in a child friendly manner.*
- *Though Jain International School places emphasis on stress-free evaluation, care is taken to ensure that children are able to cope with the Board Examinations and the slew of competitive examinations that are conducted post-Class X and Class XII.*



Education Beyond Classrooms

● Co Curricular Activities

Co-curricular activities, along with the academic programme of the school, have a very important role to play in school life. The school offers a wide range of co-curricular activities, catering to all age groups such as Dance, Yoga, Music and a host of literary activities.

In addition, intra-class, inter-House and inter-school competitions such as Extempore, Debate, Painting, Elocution, Clay Modelling, Photography, Masterchef, Flower Arrangement, Garden Art to name a few, are conducted to encourage the students to hone their skills.



● Our Fitness Strategy

An hour a day is provided for games & sports for all the students of Class I upwards. The school provides training for all games and sports under the guidance of expert coaches. The broad spectrum of game facilities includes Lawn Tennis, Basketball, Volleyball, Cricket, Skating, Football, Yoga, Table Tennis, Chess, Karate and Swimming. Every child undergoes a training module in self-defense every year.

The school boasts of an obstacle course on which the children are trained regularly to improve fitness, balance and strength.





Life in Our Campus

Students are divided into four Houses and each House takes care of major aspects such as school discipline, morning assembly, cleanliness and supervision for a fortnight. This provides an interactive and integrated platform for intellectual, emotional, physical & spiritual development.

The students are represented by the Students Council comprising of the Head-Boy, Head Girl, Prefects for Discipline, Cleanliness, Sports and Co-curricular Activities, House Captains and Vice-Captains. The entire working of the school is democratic with due importance given to the needs of the students.



International Student Partnerships



The school actively works for Academic and Cultural Student Exchange Programmes with schools abroad. We have a student-exchange programme in place with Norway and Japan. Every year new programmes are added thus allowing children a unique experience of learning.



● Clubs

The school has various Clubs to nurture the talents of students such as the Art & Craft Club, Literary Club, Maths Club, Science Club, Heritage Club, Quiz Club, Music Club - Western & Indian Music (Vocal & Instrumental), Classical Dance Club and Cookery Club. Each Club has student office bearers such as President & Secretary. Club activities are planned and organized under the guidance of a teacher who is the patron of the Club.



● Excursions... Invigorating Minds

Educational tours and excursions are regularly organised for the students both within the country and abroad to ensure that out of the classroom learning happens and the children acquire an international outlook.

● Visual And Performing Arts

Under Visual and Performing Arts, Art & Craft, Singing (Indian Classical and Western), Instrumental Music (Indian & Western) and Dance (Indian Classical and Contemporary) is offered to the students. The biennial concerts provide yet another opportunity to the students to further hone their skills and get introduced to new styles of the Arts.





Character Building

We believe that value education is the mainstay of all endeavours to transform society. We aim at building the correct attitude towards teachers, parents, peers and the environment, inculcating values that remain consistent.

Life skills are necessary to have a fulfilling life. At school, we work towards developing different life skills at all stages in a child's life, like study skills, leadership & presentation skills, effective communication skills, problem solving skills, social skills, emotional skills, thinking skills etc. In this regard, regular workshops and activities are conducted making Value Education & Life Skills an integral part of our system that is not confined merely to the classroom.





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Dining Facilities

A well furnished dining hall provides a balanced vegetarian diet which includes breakfast, lunch and afternoon snacks in hygienic conditions – a total solution to the problem of soggy and cold packed meals. While ensuring that the students have a balanced diet, the nutritious meals go a long way towards eliminating unnecessary comparisons and ensuring equality amongst them.



Hostel Facility

The school offers in-campus hostel facility only for boys of Std. XI and XII. Single, double, triple and four seater accommodation is offered with all air cooled rooms.



Transport Facilities



Jain International School runs a fleet of buses to all areas, with a comfortable pick up and drop. Short routes ensure minimum possible travel time. The safety aspect is paramount, with teachers being present on all the routes. Each bus is equipped with CCTV's and a lady conductor.



What Makes Us Distinctive

Societal Outreach

"Learning to live together" is one of the pillars of learning. The Societal Outreach Program by Jain International School focuses on developing social consciousness of the learners through simple meaningful work at the individual level and actions at a cohort level. The main objective of these projects is to direct a child's mind to constructive activities with positive outcomes through the facilitation of creative and critical thinking and empathy. We believe that students must acknowledge that they have a responsibility towards the less privileged, the disadvantaged, the society and the environment. The principle of giving to society has become second nature to them. Keeping these objectives in mind, Societal Outreach Projects like Nirmalya Collection during Ganesh Utsava, training women and children of surrounding villages in commercially viable art and craft activities, spreading socially relevant messages, donating to Old Age Homes, Orphanages etc are carried out diligently throughout the year. We believe we are creating responsible citizens in this manner.



Fast Track Your Future- Our Signature Career Guidance Initiative

'FAST TRACK YOUR FUTURE' is an innovative and exciting career guidance programme for the students. The objective behind this programme is to help students to identify their career goals at the secondary level and give them an opportunity to spend a working day with an expert in their chosen field. The students are not only given a chance to share the experiences of the experts but they also get to understand the kind of hard work, discipline, industry and commitment required to reach the heights of success in their chosen field. The initiative in collaboration with the subject experts/mentors, proves to be a fruitful experience for the students. It not only boosts their confidence but also prepares them for their future endeavors.

Morning Assemblies

An effective morning assembly is one of the most crucial parts to begin a day in a school. Jain International School concurs that a beautiful and motivational morning assembly ignites young minds towards learning and encourages them to learn more. Our morning assemblies are the most energetic and vibrant time of the school. They are well planned and carefully conducted. The assemblies are conducted by each House for two weeks. The students and teachers of the House on duty give presentations pertaining to the theme and value of that fortnight. Various Clubs also present their best activities in the assemblies providing a lot of "out of the classroom" learning. Guest speakers are also invited every fortnight to address the students on the same theme/value. The involvement of students in the presentations and conduction of the assembly increases their organisational, leadership and public speaking skills. The assemblies also provide a platform to motivate the students with appreciation, rewards and accolades for performing well in academics and co-curricular activities.



Obstacle Course Training

The obstacle course at Jain International School makes school time an adventure for kids. Training on the various equipments in the obstacle course provides great opportunities to gain multiple skills such as overall physical fitness, gross motor development, coordination, sequencing, balance and spatial awareness among kids. We are committed to the overall fitness and good posture of each child and the obstacle course is our step towards the same. Once every week children are trained on the equipments in the obstacle course.



● Adventure Camps

Adventure activities aim at increasing productivity, encouraging students to work in different working environments, building team spirit, friendship and trust amongst each other. Jain International School organises Adventure Camps every year. Our adventure camps along with thrilling adventure activities also have recreational activities, yoga and meditation sessions, leadership and organisational games and first aid sessions. Staying away from home gives the students a sense of independence and also an exposure to facing a variety of challenges, sharing responsibilities, working with other students and learning to manage their needs.



● Building as Learning Aid (BALA)

BALA is about developing the school's entire physical environment as a learning aid – the inside, the outside, the semi-open spaces – everywhere. We have innovatively treated the school space e.g. classrooms, circulation spaces, the outdoors, the natural environment, elements like the floor, walls, pillars, doors, windows, furniture, etc. to create a range of learning situations and materials. We have developed the three-dimensional space to offer a unique setting to introduce a multiple sensory experience. Visual, tactile, olfactory and specially designed kinesthetic movements inside or outside provide a unique learning experience for a child. We try to ensure that learning is a truly enjoyable and memorable experience for a child in Jain International School.





● *MUNs and Diplomathon-Developing a Global Perspective*

The students of Jain International School are prominent in the Model United Nations (MUN) scenario at the city, state, national and international level. Jain International School believes that through participating in MUNs, a child gains a perspective of world issues. The byproduct being confidence building, learning leadership and diplomatic skills. We also believe in giving an exposure to the Middle School Students to global issues. We organize and participate in 'Diplomathon' in which middle school students deliberate and discuss various issues on the lines of Model United Nations.
